Based at the National Drug Research Institute in Melbourne, this 34-month role will form part of an exciting new social science project funded by the Australian Research Council.

The project involves two key areas of work: 1) the collection of qualitative interviews with individuals self-identifying as having an AOD addiction, and with AOD service providers, and 2) the preparation of these interviews and other materials for an innovative website.

As the project's research associate you will be responsible for managing the day-to-day operations of the project, including recruiting, conducting, coding and analysing research interviews, preparing materials for the website, and contributing to the presentation and publication of research findings.
