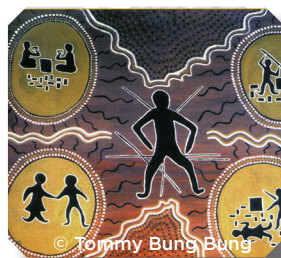

NDRI project leaders and PhD students will give brief presentations on the work NDRI does and discuss specific areas where there may be opportunities for co-supervision of PhD, Honours or Masters projects. Students will remain enrolled in their existing schools.

Opportunities for part-time and voluntary research work will also be discussed.

Students and supervisors from all Perth universities are welcome to attend the evening. It will also be an opportunity for students with an interest in drug issues studying at other universities to meet their peers and network.

NDRI will also offer a small number of competitive research bursaries to support student research.
